First, many people have been contacting our County Commissioners, FDOT, and the CCSO about the Hall's River bridge construction. I do have a couple of facts:

1. Leo Folsom, Construction Information for FDOT, emailed me that "In advance of scallop season, the contractor will install message boards and additional signage on US 19, Hall's River Road and Fishbowl Drive., alerting boaters to the single lane configuration at the bridge and to expect delays. The signal will be monitored with someone on hand to manually override if necessary to reduce the congestion for the first several weekends of scallop season."
2. Stuart Bozeman, President of Shadowoods HOA, spoke with Captain Spiddle of CCSO. Captain Spiddle himself and some of his people will survey the area prior to the opening day to develop plans to address the line of traffic blocking the inbound lane from Riverhaven Marina back toward US 19.
